This annex contains indicators for children proposed by UNICEF and partners. Top priority indicators for each target in bold.

GOAL 1

Target 1.2

- Proportion of children (aged 0-17) below the national poverty line
- Children (aged 0-17) living in multidimensional poverty

Target 1.3

 Percentage of children receiving a child or other social grant (disaggregated as possible by the child's poverty and wealth status, disability, gender and location).

Target 1.5

- Number of people affected by hazardous events by sex and age (also fits under Target 13.1 & Target 11.5)
- Proportion of health and educational facilities affected by hazardous events

GOAL 2

Target 2.2

- Prevalence of stunting (low height-for-age) in children under 5 years of age.
- Prevalence of overweight children under 5 years of age.
- Rate of exclusive breastfeeding among infants under 6 months of age (also fits under Target 2.1)
- Prevalence of wasting in children under 5 years of age
- Prevalence of anaemia in women of reproductive age

GOAL 3

Target 3.1

- Maternal deaths per 100,000 live births
- Skilled birth attendance
- Antenatal care attendance (4 or more visits)

Target 3.2

- Under-five mortality per 1,000 live births
- Neonatal mortality per 1,000 live births
- Coverage of DTP3 containing vaccine

Target 3.3

- HIV incidence per 100 susceptible person years (adults, key populations, children, adolescents)
- HIV/AIDS deaths per 100,000 population
- Number of TB deaths
- Malaria incident cases per 1,000 person years
- Malaria deaths per 100,000 population
- Prevalence of hepatitis B surface antigen in children under 5
- Presence of 13 IHR core capacities for surveillance and response

Target 3.7

- Adolescent birth rate (10-14, 15-19)
- Demand satisfied with modern contraceptives

Target 3.8

 Coverage of tracer interventions (country-specific and global) including: unmet need for family planning, skilled birth attendance, child immunisation, NTD preventive therapy, ARV therapy among all people living with HIV, TB treatment, ITN use for malaria in children under five, care seeking for pneumonia and diarrhoea treatment with ORS and zinc for children under five. (to be technically refined together with WHO, WB and others)



 Fraction of the population protected against impoverishment by out-of-pocket health expenditures

Target 3.9

 Number of premature deaths attributable to ambient and household air pollution

GOAL 4

Target 4.1

- Percentage of children who achieve minimum proficiency standards in reading and mathematics at end of: (i) grade 2, (ii) primary and (ii) lower secondary
- Completion rate (primary, lower, secondary, upper secondary)
- Gross intake ratio to the last grade (primary, lower, secondary)
- Out-of-school rate (primary, lower secondary)

Target 4.2

- Percentage of children under 5 years of age who are developmentally on track in health, learning and psychosocial well-being (ECDI and other measures)
- Percentage of children aged 24 months and above who attend an organized early learning/care and education programme.

Target 4.4

Percentage of youth/adults who are computer and information literate

Target 4.5

 Parity indices (female/male, urban/rural, bottom/top wealth quintile and other characteristics including disabilities where possible) for all indicators on this list that can be disaggregated

Target 4.6

- Percentage of youth/adults proficient in literacy and numeracy skills
- Youth/adult literacy rate

Target 4.a

 Percentage of schools providing (i) electricity; (ii) internet; (iii) computers; (iv) adapted infrastructure and materials for students with disabilities; (v) basic drinking water; (vi) basic sanitation facilities; and (vii) basic handwashing facilities

GOAL 5

Target 5.2

- Proportion of ever-partnered women and girls (aged 15-49) subjected to physical and/or sexual violence by a current or former intimate partner, in the last 12 months
- Proportion of women and girls (aged 15-49) subjected to sexual violence by persons other than an intimate partner, since age 15.

Target 5.3

- Percentage of women aged 20-24 who were married or in a union before age 18 (i.e. child marriage)
- Percentage of girls and women aged 15-49 years who have undergone FGM/C, by age group (for relevant countries only)

GOAL 6

Target 6.1

 Percentage of population using safely managed drinking water services

- Percentage of health care facilities with basic water, sanitation and hygiene facilities
- Percentage of population using basic drinking water services

Target 6.2

- Percentage of population using safely managed sanitation services
- Population with a hand washing facility with soap and water in the household
- Percentage of population using basic sanitation services
- Percentage of population practising open defecation

GOAL 7

Target 7.1

- Percentage of households primarily using clean and efficient cooking fuels and technologies
- Percentage of population with electricity access (%)
- Percentage of population with primary reliance on non-solid fuels (%)

GOAL 8

Target 8.7

 Percentage and number of children aged 5-17 years engaged in child labour, per sex and age group (disaggregated by the worst forms of child labour)

GOAL10

 UNICEF believes that global SDG monitoring should have an explicit focus on the progressive reduction of inequality gaps (ratio of disadvantaged/advantaged groups and/or the rate of change in this gap or ratio) disaggregated by age, sex, wealth, ethnicity, disability, geographic location and other characteristics relevant to national contexts

GOAL 13

Target 13.2

 Number of countries which have formally communicated the establishment of integrated low-carbon, climate-resilient, disaster risk reduction development strategies (e.g. a national adaptation plan process)

Target 13.3

- Number of countries that have integrated mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction and early warning into primary, secondary and tertiary curricula
- Percentage of population with increased knowledge on climate change, disaggregated by sex and age

GOAL 16

Target 16.1

 Homicide and conflict-related deaths per 100,000 people (disaggregated by age, sex and cause)

Target 16.2

- Percentage of young women and men aged 18-24 years who have experienced sexual violence by age 18
- Percentage of children aged 1-14 years who experienced any physical punishment by caregivers in the last month

Target 16.9

 Percentage of children under 5 whose births have been registered with civil authority
